It is **Recorder Time!** A detailed letter will be coming home with your 3rd or 4th grade child this week. I am asking that all 3rd and 4th grade students bring a Soprano Recorder to music class from now until the end of the school year. I do an annual recorder unit with all 3rd & 4th grade students and the culmination of the unit is a performance at the Spring Program in May. If you already own a soprano recorder, you do not need to purchase a new one. If your child has lost or broken their recorder from last year, or is in 3rd grade this year, please purchase them a new recorder. I have the recorders for purchase at school. Mrs. Rose Boynton, Lammersville Librarian, will be selling the recorders for me. The cost of the recorder is \$4.50. Please send cash or a check payable to Lammersville School in the amount of \$4.50. Please find Ms. Rose in the library before or after school to purchase your recorder. Third graders will begin the recorder unit on Wednesday, February 24th and the fourth graders will begin on Thursday, February 25th. Please make sure your student has his or her recorder at school beginning on those days. The 3rd grade students need to bring their recorders to music every Wednesday and 4th grade students need to bring their recorders every Thursday for their weekly music class. I will expect all students to have a recorder each week. The Spring Concert is on Thursday, May 6th at 7:00 P.M.. Please mark your calendars so all students can enjoy this exciting performance. 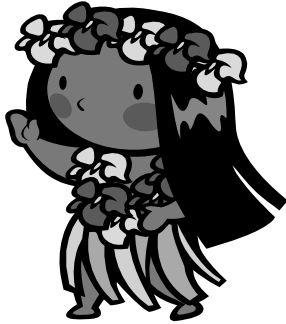

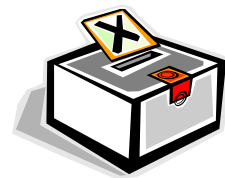
LSF NEWS
