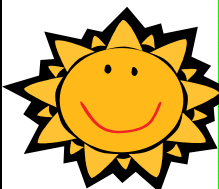

Solo and Ensemble Night in Room 13

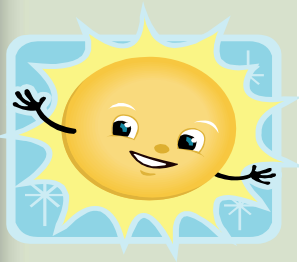
