Principal's Message

Last month you received, by mail, your child's STAR results for the testing that was administered last spring (only students in grades 2-8 take the STAR test). The results of the test are used to determine a school's API (Academic Performance Indicator). The API is a single number, ranging from a low of 200 to a high of 1000. This number reflects a school's performance level based on statewide testing. A score above 800 is considered excellent. This year, our school's API was 810! This is the 4th year in a row that we have scored over 800. As a school district, we had the highest elementary and middle school district API in San Joaquin County.

Help Protect Yourself, Your Family, and Your Community

Flu season will soon be upon us. Here are some helpful tips from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to keep you, your family, and others healthy:

- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water, especially after you cough or sneeze. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth. Germs spread this way.
- Try to avoid close contact with sick people.
- If you are sick with a flu-like illness, stay home for 7 days after your symptoms begin or until you have been symptom-free for 24 hours, whichever is longer. Except to seek medical care or for other necessities. Keep away from other household members as much as possible. This is to keep you from infecting others and spreading the virus further.

In addition, please make sure the contact information on your child's emergency card is up to date. If the school notifies you that your child is ill, please pick him or her up as soon as possible.
