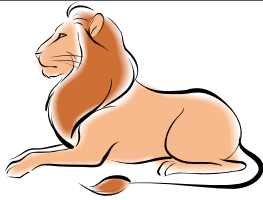

Any student in grades 4-8 who is at a doctor/dentist appointment and comes back to school, please see Mr. Herron for your prize.

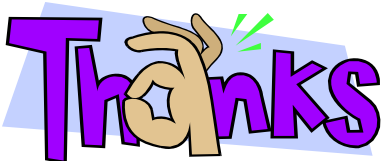

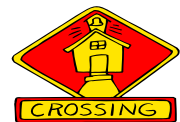
After school pickup

2:10pm Pickup at Hansen Road:

The first cars to arrive need to pull all the way up to the orange cone that is located along the fence area. This will allow more room for cars behind to line up. We want to avoid having cars extending out onto Hansen Rd. Also, please leave the driveway that leads to the bus garage and dumpster clear. This area is marked with white "No Parking" markings. It is important to stay in your car at pickup time. Do not walk up to the gate. Teachers will be assisting your students to their cars as you pull up to the pickup areas. Staff does try to get kids to their cars as quickly as possible. Thank you for being patient and understanding.

2:55pm Pickup:

Parents, please help us with the pickup at 2:55 PM. All students are to be picked up at the gate by rooms 19 and 20 and not at the front of the school. We have supervision at that gate who will assist students to their cars. As you drive up next to the fence, students are released to their cars. Please do not pick up students at the front of the school.



Planned Absences

If your child will be absent 5 or more days in a row, please inquire with your child's teacher or the office staff as soon as possible. You may be able to put your child on an Independent Study Program. This allows your student to receive attendance credit, stay current with his/her school work, and Lammersville Elementary receives funding.

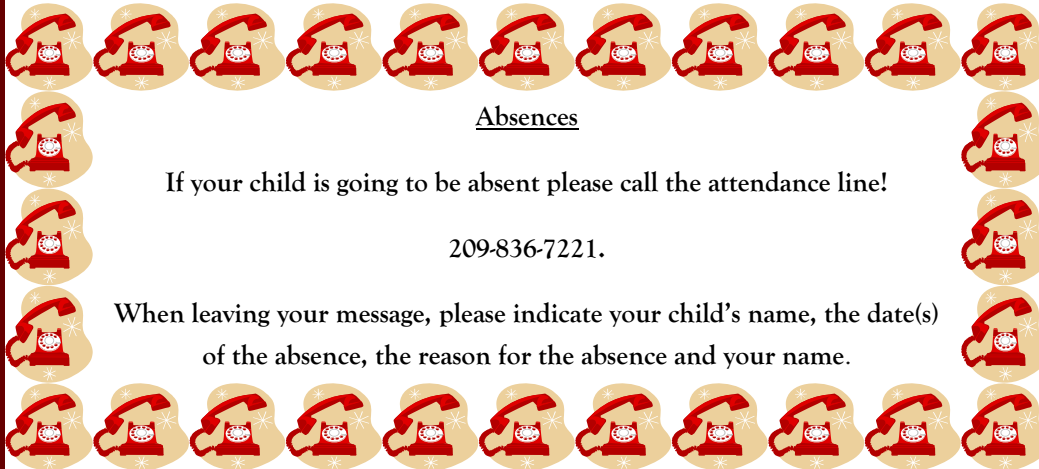
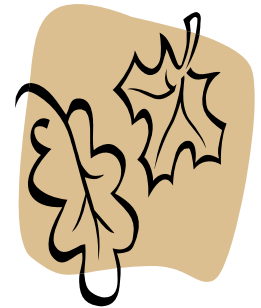
