As we complete the first trimester of the 2009-2010 school year, it was great to receive the news about our results from the California State Testing Department. The Lammersville School District not only surpassed the 800 API benchmark by all three schools, we also had the highest District score in the entire San Joaquin County. Congratulations to all the students, staff members, and parents. This is an outstanding accomplishment.

UNIFICATION

Lammersville and Tracy School Districts have submitted a joint petition for unification to the San Joaquin County Office of Education. This petition documents how the Lammersville School District has met all nine criteria's for moving forward with forming a Unified District that will include a comprehensive high school. The County will hold two public meetings to give the public a chance to comment on unification. The meeting dates and times:

October 13, 6:00pm at Tracy District Office
October 28, 6:00pm at Wicklund Elementary.

After these hearings, the County Board will make a recommendation to the California State Department of Education on unification. If everything is in order, the State would conduct an election to have the Lammersville community vote on whether they want unification.
