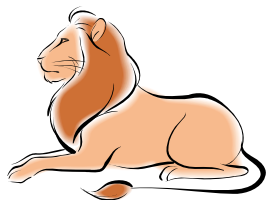

Stockton Ports Reading Program

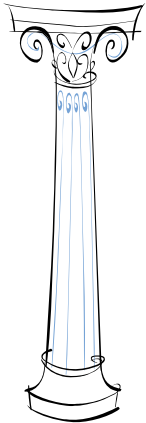

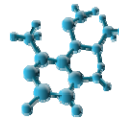
