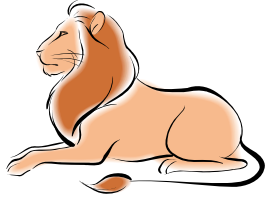

The library will be closed during the week of December 8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>. During this time, the library will be transformed into Santa's Secret workshop.

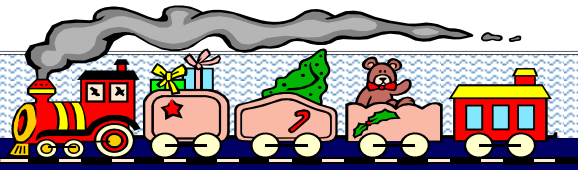


While on winter break, children will be allowed to have books out for reading with a reminder to not pack them away with Christmas decorations.


## MUSIC NOTES
